He shared the importance of building skills set in data analytics considering following points:

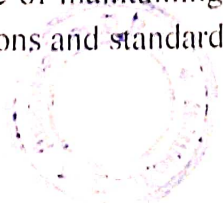



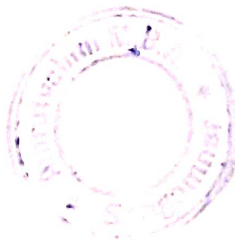
**Interactive Session:**
